FIRE FIGHTER I

Applications will be accepted each year during a one-month filing period. The filing period is from the first business day of November through the last business day of November. Applications must be filed at the Southern Region Headquarters - Fresno office to be considered for employment. For direction on how to apply, go to <https://jobs.ca.gov> and view the job posting for Fire Fighter I. (Applications will not be accepted at Sacramento Headquarters, Unit Offices, or Conservation Camps.)

As a member of a fire crew, a Fire Fighter I fights wildland, rural, and structural fires and responds to various other emergency situations including medical emergencies; repairs equipment; and is responsible for general station housekeeping.

Fire Fighter I is a seasonal, temporary classification. A Fire Fighter I is usually hired in April, May or June, and the length of employment may be up to nine months, depending on the duration and intensity of the fire season. Being a Fire Fighter I can lead to a permanent career with CAL FIRE.

Employees of this Department have the opportunity to build rewarding careers while performing work that is challenging and exciting. As a member of the CAL FIRE family, you will join the ranks of employees working together to protect the residents, resources, and property of the State of California. QUALIFICATIONS

Age: Minimum of 18 years of age at the time of appointment.

Ability to: Follow oral and written directions; do heavy physical work; exercise good judgment in hazardous fire suppression activity; accept and benefit from training in fire suppression work and techniques; work safely with others; live in a fire station compatibly with others; respond quickly to oral commands or signals in emergency situations.

Knowledge of: Good physical work methods.
