Fire Officials and Consumer Product Experts Warn of Concerns this Holiday Season


Sacramento- Every year holiday joy is marred by tragedy when accidents and fires cause injuries and even death. In order to save lives and property this year, fire officials invite the media to a multi-agency fire safety news conference. The Consumer Products Safety Commission, the State Fire Marshal and fire chiefs from the five fire districts in the Sacramento area will offer holiday safety messages and details on re-called holiday consumer items at a news conference next week. The news conference and demonstrations will be held Wednesday, December 4 starting at 10 a.m. at the Sacramento Metro Fire Station #106 at 2200 Park Towne Circle, Sacramento.

Topics will include:

- Tour of Fire Safety House
- Seven Safety Tips to care for a holiday tree (video provided to the media)
- Safety tips for deep frying a holiday turkey
- Warnings about recalled items that may still be for sale this holiday season
- Information about dangerous home heating devices
- Holiday candle safety
- Children demonstrate safe fire evacuation
- Demonstration of safety releases for iron window bars
- Television Public Service Announcements on Holiday safety will be available to the media

All speakers will be available for interviews after the demonstrations. Fire officials will also be available for interviews in Spanish and Chinese.
