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# WILDFIRE ACTIVITY STATISTICS

## FOREWORD

The California Public Resources Code directs the State Board of Forestry to designate state and privately-owned forest, watershed, and rangeland as "State Responsibility Area." The department's fire protection mission is to protect natural resources on those lands from damages by wildfire. Land not designated as State Responsibility Area is the protection responsibility of federal or local agencies.

The Department of Forestry and Fire Protection provides direct protection for most State Responsibility Area. The remainder is protected by several agencies and counties under contract with the state. The Department of Forestry and Fire Protection also contracts to provide wildland fire protection on certain federal lands, and also provides contracted life and property protection for numerous local governments.

This annual report is primarily a statistical record of fires and damages on State Responsibility Area, and on other areas which the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection protects under contract.

The Emergency Activity Reporting System became effective July 1, 1989. Fire data is entered into the computer at the fire station level, then forwarded to the ranger unit headquarters via a modem and phone lines for storage in the ranger unit database. A copy of it is then forwarded to Sacramento Headquarters for storage in the state database.

## GLOSSARY

### **CDF**

California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection

### **CONTRACT COUNTY**

Counties that protect State Responsibility Area with their fire departments. For providing that protection the counties receive payment from the state, and CDF support and reinforcement as needed for fire suppression. There are six contract counties: Kern, Los Angeles, Marin, Orange, Santa Barbara, and Ventura.

### **DIRECT PROTECTION**

The area protected by an agency with its own fire protection force.

### **FEDERAL ZONE**

The direct protection area Of U.S. Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management, National Park Service, Department of Defense, and Bureau of Indian Affairs. State Responsibility Area within federal zone is protected by federal agencies. For providing that protection the federal agencies receive payment from the state.

### **LOCAL ZONE**

Area in which there is no State Responsibility Area. In general, this is valley floor and desert land. Fire protection in local zone is provided by local government agencies; such as, cities, counties, and fire districts, or by the CDF under contract to local governments.

### **LOCAL RESPONSIBILITY FIRE**

A fire that did not burn or threaten to burn natural resources.

### **STATE RESPONSIBILITY AREA (SRA)**

The area designated by the State Board of Forestry on which the state assumes financial responsibility for protecting natural resources from damage by fire.

### **STATE RESPONSIBILITY WILDFIRE**

A fire in SRA which burns or threatens to burn natural resources.

### **STATE ZONE**

State Responsibility Area and intermingled islands of federal land protected by the CDF and contract counties. Most federal land in state zone is protected by the CDF under contracts with federal agencies.

### **WILDFIRE**

Contraction of "wildland fire." This term is used by wildland fire protection agencies to indicate a vegetation fire. Wildfire generally replaces such terms as forest fire, brush fire, range fire, and grass fire.



## 1994 FIRE SEASON SUMMARY

The State of California was anticipating an active fire season but not as quickly as the 1994 season started. The thought was, with all the rain the state had received from the 1993-94 Winter season, we would creep along until August before we would receive substantial fire activity. Wrong. Each month, with the lone exception of July, there was an increase in the number of fires compared to last years totals and 5-year average. Starting in May, and continuing through September, the Region Command Centers were staffed anywhere from 16 to 24 hours a day due to the intense activity throughout the state. Sun-downer conditions were responsible for the Hwy 41 fire in the San Luis Obispo Ranger Unit which was the largest and most destructive fire of the season. The Hwy 41 fire, which occurred on August 14th, scorched 48,531 acres and destroyed 37 structures. On August 15th, the second day of the Hwy 41 fire, the temperature was 90+ degrees, winds were gusting at 20-25 mph and the humidity in the teens. And all of this was before 8:00 in the morning. Obviously not a good day.

CDF handled over 227,000 incidents in 1994 which is an increase of 11% above last year . Of that total CDF responded to 7,207 vegetation fires which is 3% above last year and close to 3% above the 5-year average. These fires burned over 140,000 acres in CDF direct protection area.

The Department of Forestry and Fire Protection has fallen short for the third year in a row of meeting it's objective to control 95% of all initial attack fires at less than 10 acres in size. The last three years only 94% of the fires were controlled at 10 acres or less.

The 1994 Fire Season officially ended on December 24, 1994 in the Sierra-South Region.











1985-1994













## NUMBER OF WILDFIRES BY AREA














