




Graphic Figure 1. Percent of Fires by Cause




Graphic Figure 2. Number of Acres Burned — 2004-2013





Graphic Figure 3. Number of Fires — 2004-2013




Graphic Figure 4. Number of Fires by Cause — 2013, 2012 and 5 Year Average





Graphic Figure 5. Fires and Acres — 2013, 2012 and 5 Year Average




Graphic Figure 6. Fires and Acres by Region — 2013, 2012 and 5 Year Average





Graphic Figure 7. Number of Arson Fires and Acres — 2004-2013




Graphic Figure 8. Number of Fires by Time of the Day
