**PROSPECTIVE TIMBER PURCHASER:**

The California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection's Jackson Demonstration State Forest will be offering the following timber sale: SEQUOIA 2018 (309 acres), approximately 6,770 MBF (net), on December 14, 2017. The Sequoia 2018 Timber Sale is located in Township 17 North, Range 17 West, Sections 11, 14, &15; MDB&M.

Please note that the Timber Sale Agreements are in draft form as CAL FIRE is reviewing them and the existing language may be modified.

*SEQUOIA 2018*

The minimum bid rate per thousand board feet for redwood is \$800.00. The price has been fixed at \$100.00 per thousand board feet for Douglas-fir and \$100.00 per thousand board feet for all other whitewoods (grand fir/western hemlock). Single tree selection harvest will be implemented. Timber volume within these areas has been estimated by a 100 percent tally of trees designated for harvest. Sale acreage has been determined from the map, and trees selected for harvest have been marked with blue paint.

The sale area is composed of two harvest units, making up a total of approximately 309 acres. A copy of the South Fork Caspar THP (1-16-124 MEN) is available via the internet:
