Roads and Campgrounds Open

Fort Bragg– California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) Mendocino Unit has opened JDSF campgrounds and seasonal roads for the dry period. Big River Campground and Red Tail, South Bend, Wagon, and Teacher’s campgrounds in the Camp One area are closed for construction of new restrooms. These campgrounds will re-open as the construction is completed in each area. Campers are reminded the fee for camping is \$15.00 per night for single vehicles.

The Trestle Trail is also open for the season. Users are reminded that Sudden Oak Death (SOD) has been detected along the trail and precautions should be taken to minimize the spread of the disease.
